

Fair View residents enjoy visit from 4-H members and their animals

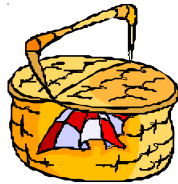
This fall, some of the children from the local 4-H chapter brought their pets to visit residents at Fair View. Below are some of the photos from the day's events.

Residents' Rights

For this month's installment of resident's rights, Jean Patrenets, CSW, takes a look at each residents' right to receive information from client advocate agencies.

In the residents' bill of rights, it states that each resident can contact representatives from these agencies at any time: Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS), State of Wisconsin Survey and Certification Licensure Office, State of Wisconsin's Long-term Care Ombudsmen, and the protection and advocacy agencies for developmentally disabled and mentally ill individuals.

The bill of rights also states that the contact information for these agencies must be posted and available to residents.

If Fair View residents or their loved ones have questions or need assistance finding this information, they can ask any of the staff members, and they will be happy to help.

Remember, if you ever feel that your loved is not given the chance to contact any of these agencies, or that any other right is being violated, contact your social worker or charge nurse.
